Cemeteries of Northern Columbia County published by the Columbia County Historical & Genealogical Society in 2000, consisting of 220 pages, is the first volume of a projected series of books enumerating burials in Columbia County cemeteries. Burials are from seventeen cemeteries in the five townships in northern Columbia County and from one cemetery in Fairmount Township in Luzerne County. In addition, the book also includes the funeral records from the former Chapin Funeral Home in Benton from 1930 to 1943.

Cemeteries of Northern Columbia County is a very valuable resource for individuals doing genealogy research. The listings include first and last names, birth and death dates, age, military service, and relationship, if available. When possible, maiden names are also included. An area map is included showing the locations of the cemeteries. A brief introduction to each cemetery is provided as well as explicit directions to each one.

Benton Township: Belles, Benton, Hamline, and Raven Creek

Fairmont Township (Luzerne Co.): Small burial site on St. Gabriel's Hill Road – Keller's Meadow

Fishing Creek Township: Dodder, Jonestown, St. James, Stillwater, and Zion

Jackson Township: Jackson and Waller

Pine Township: Pine Center and Wesley Chapel

Sugarloaf Township: Boston, Fallowbrook, St. Gabriel's, and small burial site off Five Points Road
